

## WSO Website and Database Committee April Updates

- We can use people experienced with web design, particularly Word Press.
- We support websites at adultchildren.org, acawso.org, shop.adultchildren.org, acaworldconvention.org, and now abc.adultchildren.org (Used starting in 2019)
- adultchildren.org is migrating to a new wordpress website at the end of May
  - We need all groups to test out the new website under its TEST URL wp. adultchildren.org
  - The wordpress website will be live at adultchildren.org at the end of May
  - The Meeting list registration and update process will also be enhanced to provide better security and ensure meetings are added and updated by the group contacts. We are asking that all groups have a primary and secondary email contact that will be kept private and used for ensuring only they can update the meeting. If a group cannot have an email contact, we will work with them to make updates another way.
  - The new Meeting List search feature needs to be fixed, it is not working properly yet. And we want to add better support for printable PDF meeting lists. There are also enhancements we want to make to better display the time zones for meetings
  - The new wordpress website has the daily meditation available from Strengthening My Recovery. Check it out now on the TEST URL at wp. adultchildren.org
  - Intergroups and Regions will be getting an enhancement on the new website

### Website usage statistics for April:

- 36,350 User Sessions in April down from 36,372 in March
- 107,894 pageviews, down from 110,530 Pages
- 74.9 % of users were new – no change
- The bounce rate (users leaving the site immediately) was 64.23 %, up from 64.13%
- 54.80% of users accessed the site with Mobile devices, 37.97% with a desktop, and 7.23% with a tablet
- The pages accessed the most often were
  - Laundry List – 17,622 views, 16.33 % of the total page views
  - Find a meeting – 7,393 views (6.85%)
  - Find a meeting Search results 4,803 views (4.45%)
  - Literature – 4,740 (4.39%)
  - The Problem – 2,208 views (2.05%)
- Users continue to come from across the globe with the top 5 session counts from:
  - United States – 80.58%
  - United Kingdom – 5.18%
  - Canada – 4.83%
  - Australia – 1.74%

- India– 0.61%
