On April 23 and 24, the ACA World Service Organization is holding its first ever all-online Annual Business Conference. Then, on April 25 and 26, adult children across the world will come together for the first ever Virtual Annual World Convention. Please join us for these exciting events!

ABC Registration Deadline is April 20th

All ABC delegates must register online—even if you previously registered for the now-canceled annual meeting in Boca Raton, Florida. The registration form, information and agenda, is at <https://www.acaworldconvention.org/>.

The cutoff for delegate registration is Monday, April 20 at 12pm EST.

The ABC will run from 9 am to 5 pm Eastern US time on Thursday, April 23, and Friday, April 24. Delegates must represent a registered ACA group, intergroup, or region, and have internet connection and access to Zoom.

Virtual AWC: A Day of Global Recovery!

Starting at 10 am Eastern Saturday April 25, the virtual AWC will include workshops, meetings, and speakers for 26 straight hours—hosted by fellowships around the world. This will be an unprecedented global recovery experience!
