Global and Teen & Young Adult subcommittees posted their September Reports on this website.

Global Subcommittee keeps growing each day and by the first week into October they are supporting 148 countries outside of Europe and North America. They are restructuring the international translations group and looking for different languages. They are starting a European Committee and Global Subcommittee partnership. They put the organizational chart in writing. In September they had twenty-nine country project coordinators with a working group associated with each of them. In total, Global has around 48 people working.

Teen & Young Adult Subcommittee posted its September Report on the ACA WSO
