We are working on improving communication between the membership, MSC and its subcommittees to clarify when member emails and messages are answered and the content is shared so we know the what, when, and if of the requests.

The Global Subcommittee will be submitting three ballots to the ABC in April 2021. They planned an October panel presentation with Great Lakes Intergroup and nine members of Taiwan, China, India, Israel & South Africa sharing ESH in their country. Global also ran a Ready Set Go weekend in South Africa and partnered with Toni to bring Ready Set Go to Australia weekly during October.

MSC is working toward holding virtual quarterly panels and workshops with members invited from other WSO committees and the membership. Some of the many subjects being considered include the usual ones like starting an Intergroup or Region, organizing speaker meetings and holding book study meetings in ACA; but, also some relatively new ideas like workshops on pausing the inner critical parent and inner critical child, play, non-dominant handwriting and how to set up a writing recovery meeting. More workshops or panels might cover how ACA is different from other 12-Step programs and a workshop on assisting new ACAs start an ACA recovery meeting. Out of that last one might come a much needed trifold for those many areas in the world where ACA is in its infancy.
