October/November Highlights

Converted Reader Survey to a Word Document with goal to add/revise questions. Reviewed a list of demographic questions to ensure diverse literature reader teams with ongoing discussion as to best way to collect and or disseminate data.

Literature in Development Subcommittee rescheduled Nov/Dec meetings to January and continue to recruit for working groups on Traveller.

Created new Literature Page on acawso website.

Engaged in discussion of whether documents used in workshops or meeting formats are “literature” that should go to Lit Eval or should go to Online Workshop Subcommittee of Content Collaboration Committee.

Continued work on transitioning documents from Zoho to Literature google drive.

Chairs of committee and subcommittees began regular Monday meetings.

Lit Eval added a meeting each month on Mondays at 9am ET.

Current Literature Projects

Continue to recruit for open 4 positions on Literature Evaluation Subcommittee.

Reevaluated deadline for readers of Getting Started in light of holidays.

Began process of summarizing Feedback on Existing Literature comments.

Reader evaluation of A New Hope is ready to present to Literature Evaluation; response to writer team pending.

Draft letter to WSO Board regarding workshop documents being finalized.

Reader team evaluation of Connections document complete and ready for Literature Evaluation.

Longer Term Projects:

Post all ballot proposals relating to literature to the wso website.

Evaluate what information about Literature should appear on adultchildren.org website.

Propose changes to OPPM relating to Literature and Publishing.

Work with Publishing Committee to write "Writer Guidelines" for publishing issues such as design, graphics, and efficient interface with Publishing.

Work with the Publishing Committee to create a process for literature document identification of "master documents," storage and retrieval.

Evaluate and make recommendations about free literature.

Work with Literature in Development Subcommittee to assess existing trifold with a view toward retiring, revising, combining, turning into a searchable web-based resource or continuing as is.
